

A public journey review of our own site.

A demonstration on our own website, not a client engagement. The tested sample interactions worked. One navigation recommendation would make the detailed offer easier to find. No conversion lift, lost revenue or customer acceptance was measured.

Tested September 13, 2026, 03:10:23-03:10:28 UTC (September 12, 10:10 PM Central). Chromium 145.0.7632.6 at 1440 x 1000 and 390 x 844 CSS pixels. Review coordinated by the Codex lead for Beard Byte Labs.

Coverage and results

Journey	Result and observation
Find the offer	Recommendation. Homepage and workbench load; the workbench anchor resolves. No direct homepage link reaches the detailed Catalog Rescue offer.
Inspect the sample	Checks passed. Keyboard activation switches to the proposed view. Protected values remain unchanged. All five downloads return HTTP 200 and match the reviewed source bytes.
Prepare an inquiry	Link verified only. The scope-inquiry link addresses support@beardbytelabs.com. We did not open an email client, send a message or test delivery in this review.

Coverage limits

Two public pages only: the homepage and /catalog-rescue. No page overflow or uncaught JavaScript errors were observed in these two runs. A viewport check is not physical-device testing. Safari, other browsers, screen readers, broader accessibility conformance, network stress, authenticated pages, carts, checkout, payments, form submissions and email delivery were not tested. This is not a security review or a guarantee that the site is defect-free.

One recommendation. A reproducible finding.

BBL-QA-001: connect the homepage to the detailed offer

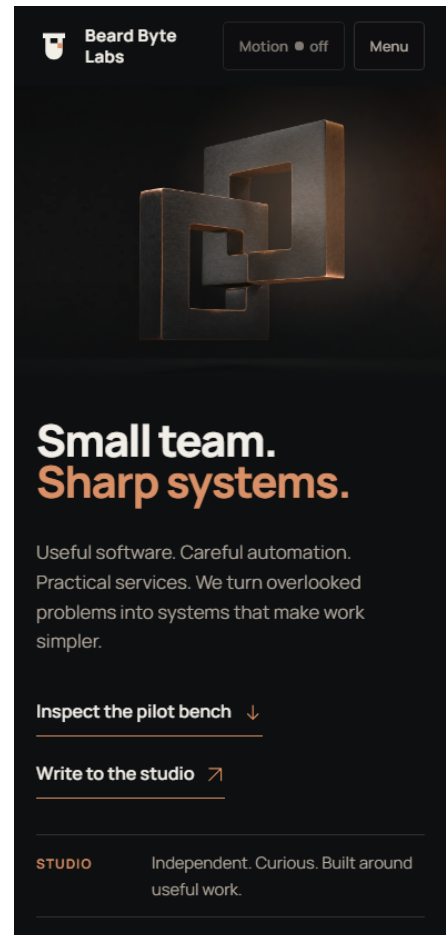
Classification: usability recommendation. Open at original observation. This is not a broken-feature claim or evidence of lost sales.

Reproduction steps

1. Open <https://beardbytelabs.com/>.
2. Follow "Inspect the pilot bench"; confirm the workbench opens.
3. Inspect the homepage links for a route to /catalog-rescue. Both viewport runs found zero.
4. Open /catalog-rescue directly; the offer exists and returns HTTP 200.

Suggested next action

Add a clearly named link from the workbench introduction to the detailed offer. Retain the working sample and visible inbox. Recheck the exact homepage link after deployment; keep this original observation as history. The expected behavior here is our review criterion, not a previously documented product requirement.
